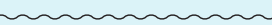

WEEK 1

WEEK 2

People hear that Jesus is coming so they spread coats and palm branches on the road and shout, "Hosanna!"

Matthew 21:1-11; John 12:12-15

What did the people put on the road to make a special path for Jesus? (Coats and branches)

Who can celebrate Jesus? (Everyone)

WEEK 3

People hurt Jesus, and He dies. On the third day, Jesus comes back and is alive forever!

Matthew 26:36, 47-50; 27:1-2, 11-66; 28:1-8

Who came back just like He said He would? (Jesus)

Why do we celebrate Easter? (Jesus is alive!)

WEEK 4

After Jesus comes back, He cooks breakfast for His friends, the disciples, and they are so happy to see Him!

John 21:1-14

Who was on the beach making breakfast for His friends? (Jesus)
Who wants to be your friend forever? (Jesus)
