Who came back just like He said He would? (Jesus) Why do we celebrate Easter? (Jesus is alive!)

WEEK 4

After Jesus comes back, He cooks breakfast for His friends, the disciples, and they are so happy to see Him!

John 21:1-14

Who was on the beach making breakfast for His friends? (Jesus) Who wants to be your friend forever? (Jesus)
