**WEEK 1**  
**Jesus washes His disciples' feet and then tells them to love others the way He has loved them.**

John 13:3-7, 34-35

Why didn't Peter want Jesus to wash his feet? (Because he thought Jesus was too important to do such a messy job)

Why did Jesus wash his friends' feet? (To show them how to love others)

**WEEK 2**

**Jesus is kind and gentle to a woman after she touches Him so she can be healed.**

Mark 5:25-34

Was Jesus kind to the woman who touched his robe without asking? (Yes)

Who can love others by being kind and gentle? (Me!)

**WEEK 3**

**Jesus feeds over 5,000 hungry people with only five loaves of bread and two fish.**

John 6:1-13

How much fish and bread did the boy have? (Two fish and five loaves of bread)

Who can love like Jesus by sharing with others? (Me!)

**WEEK 4**

**Jesus invites people with different jobs and backgrounds to follow Him because Jesus loves everyone.**

The Gospels

Why did Jesus invite people from different families and different jobs to follow him? (Because Jesus loves everyone!)

Who does Jesus want to follow Him? (Everyone)
