WEEK 3

Elijah and a woman trust God, and God keeps the oil and flour from running out.

1 Kings 17:1-16

Who made bread for Elijah? (The woman)
Who kept the oil and flour from running out?
(God)

WEEK 4

God hears King Hezekiah when he prays for his city and when he is very sick.

Isaiah 37:14-21, 35; 39:1-6

Who prayed and talked to God about his city?
(King Hezekiah)

Who can pray and talk to God about anything?
(Everyone)
