MEET THE MOLLY LEE MISSIONS TEAM: MOLLY LEE

WHAT IS YOUR ROLE ON THE MISSIONS TEAM?

Global Teams Coordinator, I help the missions pastor with all things global! From planning future trips, to spreading the word about available trips, to helping prepare existing teams, I handle all the administrative and logistic details for global missions teams.

HOW DID YOU GET STARTED WITH MISSIONS?

When my husband and I first came to GT we were looking for ways to get more involved and serve. Missions stuck out to us because we both have such a strong love for traveling and seeing the world. It was a perfect fit from the start, and now we get to travel with a purpose.

HOW HAS BEING INVOLVED IN MISSIONS IMPACTED YOUR FAITH?

Through missions I have gotten to see God move in so many different ways, not just in my life but in the lives of many others too. God is so faithful. He always makes a way, and I'm not just talking about providing financially either, but experiencing His provision and getting to be a part of His intricate plans has helped me to get to know Him on a much more intimate level.

HOW HAVE YOU SEEN GOD MOVE ON YOUR MISSIONS TRIPS?

I was part of the Cuba global team in 2019. We were all set to leave; our team had been preparing for months, suitcases were packed, and the missionary had even flown into NJ to escort us into the country. Hours before we left for the airport the missionary called me and said "This has never happened before, I can't believe I'm telling you this but the team's visas haven't been issued. We can't go." Needless to say we were all so devastated and confused. We couldn't understand why God wasn't making a way for us to go there. We all knew the visa situation was very tense but we just had faith that God would make it happen. Fast forward one month later and we finally made it to Cuba. On our second day there, the hosts told us how there were two nationals working with them that didn't know Jesus. They also said that had we come a month earlier those workers wouldn't have been there. Realization hit our entire team in that moment, God's timing was so perfect we just couldn't see it until right then. We got to spend a week forming relationships with those workers and we got to witness first hand the dramatic changes in them as they became curious about Jesus, and then accepted Him as

their Savior! Praise God!

DO YOU HAVE ANY ADVICE FOR PEOPLE WHO MIGHT BE CONSIDERING GOING ON AGLOBAL TRIP FOR THE FIRST TIME?

I always hear people say that if you are considering going on a trip to 'just do it'. I want to take that a step further though and say 'when you do it (because you totally should), go with high expectations.' God will definitely move in your life and you will be blessed to witness Him moving in others' lives, but He can do more than you could ever imagine! So sign up for a trip and go expecting Him to do amazing things, and then watch in awe when He shows up big.
