WEEK 1

Jesus asks four fishermen named Peter, Andrew, James, and John to follow Him, and they become Jesus' friends.

Matthew 4:18-22

What was Peter, Andrew, James, and John's job when they met Jesus? (They were fishermen.)
What did Jesus say to Peter, Andrew, James, and John? ("Follow Me.")

WEEK 2

Jesus asks Matthew to follow Him and be His friend, even though Matthew has made bad choices.

Matthew 9:9-10

Who wanted to be Matthew's friend forever? (Jesus)
Who loves everyone? (Jesus)

WEEK 3

Philip tells his friend Nathanael about Jesus, and they both follow Jesus and become His friends.

John 1:43-49

Who does Philip tell about Jesus? (His friend Nathanael)
Who follows Jesus? (Philip and Nathanael)

WEEK 4

Jesus chooses 12 people, from different jobs and families, to follow Him and become His friends, the disciples.

Matthew 4:18-22, 9:9-10, 10:2-4;
John 1:43-49

Who showed the disciples how to love everyone? (Jesus)
Who wants everyone to follow Him? (Jesus)
