

WEEK 1

Noah trusts God's plans and builds an ark for his family and two of every kind of animal.

Genesis 6-7

Who trusted God when no one else did? (Noah)
What did God ask Noah to build? (A big boat)

WEEK 2

God put a rainbow in the sky as a symbol of His promise to never flood the whole world again.

Genesis 8-9:17

What did God put in the sky as a sign of His promise? (A rainbow)
Who keeps His promises? (God)

WEEK 3

Joseph keeps trusting God's plans even when hard things happen to him.

Genesis 37; Genesis 39-40

Who sent Joseph far away to work in Egypt? (Joseph's brothers)
Who trusted God even when things were very hard? (Joseph)

WEEK 4

Joseph trusts God's plans and tells Pharaoh to save grain for seven years.

Genesis 41-45

Who helped Pharaoh, king of Egypt, understand his dreams? (Joseph)
Who followed God's plan and saved food for seven years? (Joseph)

WEEK 5

God knows the plans He has for us.

Jeremiah 29:11

Who had plans for Noah and Joseph? (God)
Who has plans for you? (God)
