WEEK 1

WEEK 2

On day three, God made the land, plants, and seas, and it was good.

What are some things you can do on land? (Run, jump)

What are some things you can do in the water? (Splash, swim)

WEEK 3

On day four, God made the sun, moon, and stars, and it was good.

What did God put in the sky to give us light during the day? (Sun)

What did God put in the sky to give us light at night? (Moon and stars)

WEEK 4

On day five, God made the sea animals and birds, and it was good.

Can you name some animals God created that live in the water?

Can you name some different birds God made?

WEEK 5

On day six, God made land animals and people, and it was very good. Then, God rested on day seven.

Can you move like some of the animals God made? (Wiggle like a worm, jump like a frog, etc.)
